Narrative of Incident Sheriff Dallas Baldwin states:

On Monday, January 29th, at approximately 2:00 p.m., a Franklin County Sheriff's Office deputy was following up on a reported Hit/Skip from January 22nd. On that date, a Hit/Skip was reported in the vicinity of EB I-270 and Highway 23.

In that incident, following the Hit/Skip, the driver of the suspect vehicle fled the scene on foot immediately thereafter. However, as the initial incident was a non-injury event, a report was taken and filed for later follow up.

On January 29, 2018, as a part of the follow up, the deputy attempted to contact the registered owner of the vehicle and was informed that that person had been missing for approximately one week, although no missing persons report was filed.

In the course of the follow up, the FCSO deputy reviewed the original report and retraced the steps detailed, with the assistance of other FCSO deputies. It was during this that they discovered the body of an adult male, located in a wooded area off EB I-270 at Highway 23.

The Franklin County Coroner has identified the body as that of Jeremy Wade Boggs, 41, of Delaware, OH. Next of kin has been notified.

The FCSO confirms that Mr. Boggs was the driver from the original Hit/Skip.

The Franklin County Sheriff's Office Accident Investigations Unit is continuing to investigate the incident.
